

The History of Rebuilding Together

In the Beginning - A Dream Comes True

Christmas in April, the predecessor to Rebuilding Together, was founded in 1972 in Midland, Texas. Renamed Rebuilding Together in 2000, the organization has grown to include a national network of over 230 chapters serving 1,880 communities. Since its founding, 2.5 million Rebuilding Together volunteers have renovated over 100,000 homes and provided over \$1 billion in market value for neighbors in need. Additionally, Rebuilding Together has teamed with other organizations and major corporations nationally to perform many community projects.

The Dream Comes to Indy

Rebuilding Together Indianapolis was founded in 1999. Over the years, more than 260 homes for the elderly, disabled and families in need within the Indianapolis community have been renovated. In addition, numerous community projects have been completed such as new parks and neighborhood church and community center repairs. By leveraging funding through the implementation of volunteer assistance and in-kind donations, the value of the completed work to date in Indianapolis is estimated at over \$6 million.

Kickoff to Rebuild Event

Kickoff to Rebuild is an annual NFL sanctioned event hosted by Rebuilding Together. For 17 years, Rebuilding Together has partnered with the NFL to bring our mission of preserving home ownership and revitalizing low-income communities to Super Bowl cities. On February 3, 2012, hundreds of volunteers, past and present NFL members and players, Indianapolis community leaders, well-known national celebrities, and local and national sponsors revitalized ten homes in the Super Bowl Legacy Neighborhood of Near Eastside. Rebuilding Together and Lowe's also partnered with Carter's Kids to build a brand new playground at the State Avenue Park as part of the Kickoff to Rebuild Pre-Game.

Rebuilding Together Indianapolis culminates in a one-day work blitz in the spring known as National Rebuilding Game Day. Work is done with families, not for them. Homeowners and family members are asked to participate as extensively as possible in the rehabilitation of their homes.

Neighborhood Selection Process

Applications are sent to the Community Development Corporations and those submitted are then reviewed by the Neighborhood Selection Committee. Finalists are invited for a one-on-one interview and then a recommendation is made by the Neighborhood Selection Committee. Upon approval of the Board of Directors, the selected neighborhood is notified and applications for homeowners participation are solicited.

Homeowner Selection Process

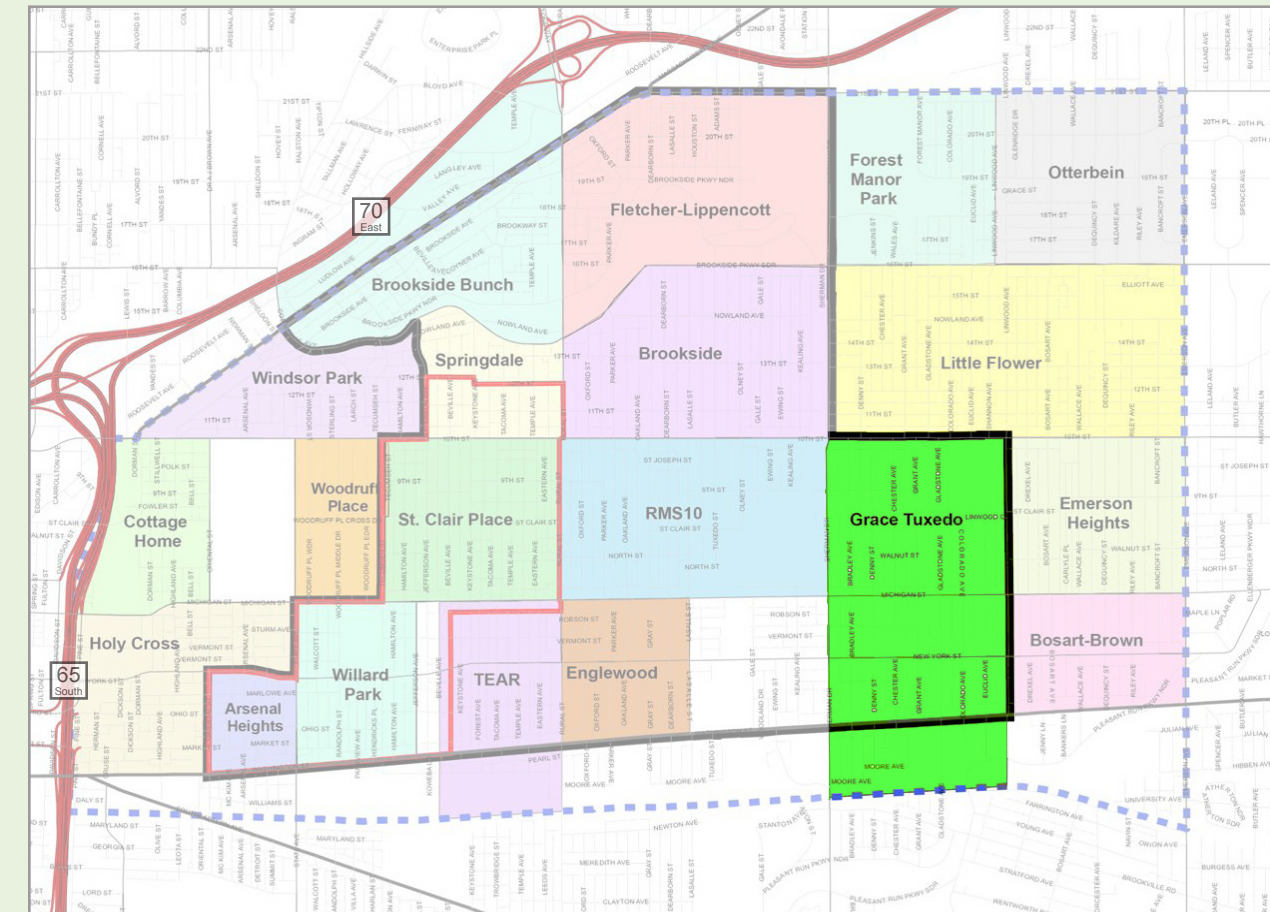
Homeowners are invited to attend an informational meeting put on by Rebuilding Together Indianapolis. Homeowners are low-income, elderly, or disabled who are unable to complete necessary repairs in their home. Applications are reviewed by the Selection Committee. Decisions are based on the applicant's need and ability to complete the work.
