Rebuilding Together Indianapolis helps people who own their own home; but, because of physical limitations or low income, are struggling to cover the costs of home repairs. Each April—known as National Rebuilding Month—the Indiana Union Construction Industry, its contractors, and community volunteers come together to do more than half a million dollars’ worth of home repairs. And with the help of sponsorships and grants, Rebuilding Together Indianapolis also partners with community groups and companies to complete projects throughout the year.



